- Literacy Goal: We will improve student achievement in **literacy**, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.
 - The strategy will be for teachers to become familiar with and implement all parts of the Writer's Workshop model and be able to effectively create small groups to support writing during the independent portion of the workshop.
- Math Goal: We will improve student achievement in **mathematics**, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.
 - The strategy will be teachers will examine the end of Term 1 Computational Fact Fluency with a grade level partner and will co-create ways to gather evidence of learning beyond math running records (note: running records are grade 3 and above only).
