Business arising from the minutes:

Excel: excel has completed a site analysis, AM site will host, & pre-primaries can come for the afterschool portion of program. Survey has been sent for enrollment as well as employment. Carrie to provide surveys to excel later this week & could potentially start in January. Carrie to provide update when available. Current location is meeting in a changing room & the gym.

Breakfast program; all classes have bins with food items. Students have access at all times.

Carrie to meet with a parent who expressed interest in supporting additional opportunities related to food/the Breakfast Program.

Plan small & increase food offering – as opposed to decreasing if it's not sustainable.

Multi-cultural resources – Carrie & Lisa will look at options via budget if there are additional items needed to support the school.

Student success plan:

Wellbeing goal: same as last year + with a specific focus on African, Mi'Kmaw,/Indigenous Currently: 4-6 week cycle instead of a 10 month goal. Outdoor play area, engaging & safe. Have not yet worked on literacy & math goals – these will be next.

Common, defined, rules are working to be established.

Not as much commotion as in previous times – seeing improvement.

Literacy & math will be updated/created by next meeting.

Principal's report:

Virtual first PD day due to mold at school. Went well.

Current classroom breakdown:

11 classrooms total

2 primary

1 x grade 1

2x split grade ½

1 x grade 2

1 x grade 3

1 x split grade ³⁄₄

1 x grade 4

1 x spilt grade 4/5

1 x grade 5

3 classes over cap. Waiting for updates from RCE.

Grades p-2 have a cap of 22 cap

Grades 2 – 5 have a cap at 27

Possible scenarios to deal with classes over caps: NO new portables being added to sites at the moment – could add a class if space or add a cap teacher.

Total number of students: approx. 264 without pre-primaries, 292 with pre-primaries (who are at Terence Bay site).

Bus drop off & pickup at Shad Bay site: changes – met with STC, talk about strategies to deal with increased busses, yellow line painting to control walking flow/safety of students, kiss & go drop-off, encouraged kids to get out on sidewalk side.

Pizza will return mid-October & milk program, fridge donated from Rondeau's. Not avail to pre-primaries at Terence Bay site.

New swing installed – accessibility swing (funding from MLA) Learning centre students are really enjoying ability to participate.

Fact fluency resource cart (bingo chips, dice, deck of cards etc for tools for math facts/fluency).

Sports bins.

Just ordered & received a sound wall – to go with the you fly literacy program. What is their tongue doing, mouth doing, vocal chords doing etc. \$367 spent

Some classes need kidney shaped tables - for the way we teach now they should be a requirement
